

Instructions for Integrated MS Students at KSKGRL

Welcome to Dr. K S Krishnan Geomagnetic Research Laboratory (KSKGRL) Prayagraj, under the Indian Institute of Geomagnetism (IIG). To ensure your stay is comfortable, safe, and hassle-free, please read the following guidelines carefully.

(a) Essential Documents

- Admission letter and fee payment details.
- Original educational certificates with self-attested photocopies.
- Government-issued photo ID (Aadhaar/Passport, etc.).
- Passport-size photographs (2–4 copies).
- Medical records, vaccination certificate (if applicable), and health insurance details, if any.

(b) Clothing (at Prayagraj, Optional)

Summer (March–June)

- Light cotton clothes.
- Cap/hat and sunglasses.
- Comfortable sandals/shoes.
- Water bottle to stay hydrated.

Monsoon (July–September)

- Umbrella or raincoat.
- Waterproof footwear/ slippers.
- Extra towels and quick-dry clothes.
- Plastic covers for books, laptop, and important documents.

Winter (November–February)

- Sweaters, jackets, and thermal wear.
- Woollen cap, gloves, muffler, and socks.
- Blanket or quilt (if not provided by the hostel).

(c) Bedding and Hostel Essentials

- Bedding
- Bedsheets
- Pillow and pillow covers.
- Blanket/comforter.

(d) Personal Hygiene Items (as per the requirement)

(e) Stationery

- Notebooks.
- Pens, pencils, marker, and highlighter.
- Scientific calculator (if required).
- Folder for important documents.

(f) Food and Hydration

- Reusable water bottle.
- Small airtight containers.
- Avoid eating unhygienic street food during the initial weeks.

(g) General Hygiene Tips

- Wash hands frequently.
- Keep your room clean and well-ventilated.
- Dispose of waste properly.
- Wash clothes regularly.
- Maintain personal cleanliness to prevent infections.

(h) Safety Guidelines

- Save important emergency contacts.
- Inform family about your arrival.
- Keep valuables locked.
- Be cautious while traveling at night.
- Students are strictly advised not to enter restricted areas in the campus

(i) Formal Attire

Students are advised to bring **at least one or two sets of formal clothing**, as formal dress may be required during the course for:

- Academic presentations and seminars.
- Guest lectures and workshops.
- Viva-voce examinations.
- Departmental meetings.

(j) Academic Preparation

- Review the academic calendar.
- Carry course-related books if required.
- Install required academic software.
- Attend orientation and departmental meetings.
