SJR : SCImago Journal Rank : SJR (SCImago Journal Rank) indicator

It expresses the average number of weighted citations received in the selected year by the documents published in the selected journal in the three previous years, --i.e. weighted citations received in year X to documents published in the journal in years X-1, X-2 and X-3.

SJR calculation

average # of weighted citations received in a year

of documents published in previous 3 years

CiteScore : **CiteScore** is the number of citations received by a journal in one year to documents published in the three previous years, divided by the number of documents indexed in Scopus published in those same three years.

CiteScore for 2015 counts the citations received in 2015 to documents published in 2012, 2013 or 2014, and divides this by the number of documents published in 2012, 2013 and 2014.
